Hosting events at the National Maritime Museum provides the singular opportunity to privately enjoy this monument to British maritime history, the extensive national collection it houses, and enjoy the newly refurbished Great Map space in the central atrium.

Welcome back to the National Maritime Museum

The National Maritime Museum is the flagship space of Royal Museums Greenwich and the central atrium - Oceans Court - is perfect for events for up to 1000 guests.

Enjoy a standing reception across two floors. The Streets, on ground level, allow your guests to get up close with some of our treasured large scale artefacts, and the Great Map space on the mezzanine level under the brand new glass roof is the heart of the space.

Telling stories about British history, this space also looks to the future and poses questions and potential solutions about what we can do to operate sustainably across the globe.

Ocean Court reopened in June after a substantial refurbishment that saw a new roof installed, the walls painted and a new Great Map designed and installed. Join us as we welcome back this iconic venue.
